ON THE MANAGEMENT OF COLLEGES AND INSTITUTIONS MAINTAINED BY THE UNIVERSITY

Under Section 26 (1) (o) of the NEHU Act, 1973

- 1. There shall be an Advisory Committee for a College or Institution maintained by the University.
- 2. i. The responsibility of the Advisory Committee shall be as follows:
 - a. to advise on the programmes of teaching in the college and to determine the teaching requirements of the colleges.
 - b. to propose new teaching posts in various departments and suggest expansion of the departments, if necessary.
 - c. to regulate the admission of the students for the various courses of the colleges within the framework of the policy laid down by the University.
 - to formulate guidelines for hostel accommodation and welfare of students.
 - e. to formulate guidelines regarding discipline of students.
 - f. to propose academic programmes such as seminars, conference, extension work etc. for the specific requirements of the college.
 - g. to lay down guidelines for purchase of library books and laboratory equipment in consultation with the appropriate departments.
 - ii. The Advisory Committee will be constituted as follows:
 - a. The Vice-Chancellor or his nominee -Chairman
 - b. Two members to be nominated by the Executive Council from among the reputed educationists of the concerned state.
 - c. Four members of the teaching staff of the concerned college by rotation in order of seniority.
 - d. Director of Public Instruction/Director of Higher Education of the concerned state.
 - e. The Principal of the concerned college (Ex-officio Member Secretary).
 - iii. Members, others than ex-officio members, shall hold office for a term of two years.
 - iv. The quorum for the meeting of the Advisory Committee shall be four.
