

**ON THE ADMISSION OF STUDENTS TO THE UNIVERSITY
INCLUDING ITS AFFILIATED COLLEGES**

Under Section 26(1) (a) of the NEHU Act, 1973

Existing Provisions:

1. Without prejudice to the provisions of the Act and Statutes, and other rules of the University, a student shall be eligible for admission to any Under-Graduate or Post-Graduate Course of study under the University if he has passed the examination or examinations prescribed by the University for admission to the concerned course or courses.
2. The candidates seeking admission to a course of study in the University including the affiliated colleges, must satisfy the concerned rules and conditions.
3. Foreign students may be admitted to various programmes of study under the following categories :
 - A) Cultural Exchange Fellowship programme of Govt. of India;
 - B) Self-financing students;
 - C) Short-term programmes (not leading to award of any degree/diploma/certificate).

New Clause Proposed to be added:

4. All aspects of admission of foreign students, including procedure of admission, reservation of seat, qualification, fee structure, etc., shall be prescribed in a separate regulation.
